Dear Parents, Staff and Pupils

By the end of this week, we would have had the matric students at school for two weeks. The new hybrid learning and teaching process has by and large worked well, except for a few technical challenges. Teachers continue to record the live lessons for girls to access as required.

We received an inspection from the Department of Health and their report was very complimentary, indicating that all our protocols are in place and working well. We have received a response from the Provincial Education Department approving our application for phasing in of other grades.

On Wednesday 17 June we will be ready to welcome back our Grade 11 pupils at 07h30. As per the previous communications we outline below the process to be adhered to when pupils and staff return to school:

- All staff and pupils must wear face masks for the duration of their stay at school.
- Pupils may return in civvies and are not required to wear school uniform.
- Pytchley entrance is to be used for arrival and departure of pupils.
- Upon arrival at school, all staff and pupils will need to complete a declaration of health form (attached). If a pupil is under 18 years old, a parent is required to co-sign the form.
- The driver's temperature will be scanned at Pytchley gate and when pupils approach the bus shelter gate their temperature will be taken.
- Once the pupil has been permitted to enter the school grounds, then the parents may drive off.
- Should either the driver or the pupil present with a temperature of 38°C or higher, they will not be allowed to enter the school grounds.
- St Angela's lawn has been divided into 1,5m squares. Upon arrival, the Grade 11s will sit on a chair appropriately distanced from one another, for their orientation programme.
- Each classroom has been set up with no more than 20 desks and a wall mounted sanitising station, equipped with sanitiser dispenser, paper towel dispenser and a waste bin.
- Green circles in the car park, along the corridors and outside the tuckshop indicate where pupils need to stand when waiting in a line.
